When Rose took guests on her first game drive as a qualified guide, accompanied by Abraham, she was cheered and congratulated by ZAWA staff at the entrance to the park, and a full staff vehicle from Mfuwe Lodge erupted into clapping and cheers of "Well Done Rose".
